


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



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Purpose of Workshop


- **Use plenary presentations to:**




- **Stakeholder participation**

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Working Agreement


- **All ideas are valid**

- **Complete draft report by end of meeting**



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HUMAN FACTORS INFLUENCING OUR THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING PROCESS


- We all have biases and assumptions
- Unconscious assumptions and thinking
- We seek patterns in events
- We choose a pattern or interpretation with limited analysis
- We select data that support our preference
- We ignore data that disagree with our preference
- We start our analyses with conclusions – rather than defining our problems and needs
- Difficult to evaluate in our heads all of the interactions in complex problems. Thinking tools can help.
- Groups of people are more productive of ideas and more inclusive of options than individuals working alone.



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Role of the Facilitator


- **Keep purposes front and center**
- **Encourage equal participation**
- **Do not evaluate ideas presented**
- **Keep group memory – flip charts**
- **Capture basic ideas**
- **All contribution have equal weight**
- **Keep deadlines and produce product**



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Role of Participants

- **Manage your own working group discussions**
- **Provide information and determine issues of concern**
